Moreover, papers which approach topics such as listed above from theoretical and analytical perspectives sourced from anywhere across the humanities, social and cognitive sciences, including but not limited to the following, are welcomed:

- Psycholinguistics and sociolinguistics
- Functional and cognitive linguistics
- Corpus linguistics
- Discourse analysis
- Ethnography of communication and culture
- Media and mass communication studies
- Discursive psychology.

We especially welcome papers which re-examine existing theoretical frameworks and/or which highlight and apply new methodologies.

### **Submission**

Only original, previously unpublished research papers, review, survey and tutorial papers, application papers, plus case studies, short research notes and letters, on both applied and theoretical aspects, should be submitted. Submission implies that the manuscript has not been published previously, and is not currently submitted for publication elsewhere. Submission of a manuscript is interpreted as a statement of certification that no part of the manuscript is copyrighted by any other publisher nor is under review by any other formal publication. It also implies that the corresponding author has consent of all authors. It is the author's responsibility to ensure that the manuscript does not cause any copyright infringements, defamation, and other problems.

Manuscripts in MS Word must be written in English following the rules of academic style where high-quality grammar and style is essential. All the papers, except for surveys, should ideally be 6 - 15 pages in length. Submissions must include – apart from the main text - the following elements: title, authors, affiliations, contacts, abstract, key words, and when applicable: introduction, main text, conclusions, appendixes, acknowledgement, references, and biographies.

Papers should be formatted into A4-size pages, with main text of 12-point Times New Roman, in single-spaced one-column format. Figures and tables must be sized as they are to appear in print. Figures should be placed exactly where they are to appear within the text. Other formats are not acceptable. Authors are strongly advised to follow the attached template.

Authors should submit their paper electronically through email to the Journal's submission address as below.

Each paper will be provided with a paper ID for further reference. Please always refer to the paper ID in the submissions and any further enquiries.

### **Submission and review process**

1. Upon receipt of **paper submission**, the editorial assistant sends an e-mail of confirmation to the corresponding author within 1-3 working days. If you fail to receive this confirmation, your submission/e-mail may have been missed. Please contact the Editor-in-Chief at ([slovakedu@gmail.com](mailto:slovakedu@gmail.com)).
2. **Peer review**. We use double-blind system for peer-review. All manuscripts will be subject to a well established, fair, unbiased peer review and refereeing procedure, and considered on the basis of their significance, novelty and usefulness to the journal's readership. The reviewers' identities remain anonymous to authors. The review process may take 2 to 3 weeks.
3. **Notification** of the result of review.  
The review output will be one of the following decisions:
  - Accept
  - Accept with minor changes
  - Accept with major changes
  - Reject

4. If required, authors need to revise the paper according to reviewer's comments. After final acceptance of the paper (the author receives an acceptance letter via e-mail), the author will be sent an invoice to pay the **publication fee** (EUR 70).
5. After completing the bank transfer of the fee, the paper will be immediately published on the journal website. The complete version of the journal issue in PDF will be published on the journal's webpage on September 30 / January 31 / May 31. After publishing, the authors may download the journal from the website.
6. **After publication** of the complete journal issue, the corresponding author will receive one copy of printed journals, free of charge.

### **Copyright**

Submitted papers are assumed to contain no proprietary material unprotected by patent or patent application; responsibility for technical content and for protection of proprietary material rests solely with the author(s) and their organizations and is not the responsibility of the SlovakEdu or its Editorial Staff. The main author is responsible for ensuring that the article has been seen and approved by all the other authors. It is the responsibility of the author to obtain all necessary copyright release permissions for the use of any copyrighted materials in the manuscript prior to the submission.

The journal has a policy of “**Zero Tolerance to Plagiarism**”. We check plagiarism via two methods: reviewer check and plagiarism prevention tool (ithenticate.com). All submissions will be checked by iThenticate before being sent to reviewers.

### **Publication Charges**

JoLaCE is an Open Access journal. It charges a manuscript-publication fee for every accepted manuscript, to cover the costs incurred by open-access publication, website maintenance, promotion, printing and shipping expenses. The regular charge is EUR 70 or equivalent local currency (one free hard copy included).

Authors may ask for the services of a professional editor if they need assistance with grammar and style. If required, professional language checking of the submitted and accepted paper will be charged EUR 7 per a standard page (= 1,800 figures).

One free hard copy is included in the publication charge. Authors can order extra hard copies of the issue at the price of EUR 20 each copy.
